The PLM User Initiative provides companies with a managed framework to interact and collaborate with each other throughout 2008. It enables participants to combine experience and best practice, and to derive specific solutions to their own most important PLM problems.

The User Initiative will commence with registration during March and April, and will complete its final deliverables in March 2009.

Aim

To enable a group of companies to gain synergy from their PLM implementations to generate and quantify a common set of PLM Best Practices, and to enhance the PLM implementation of each participant by focused application of the new knowledge, tools and metrics.
